Dear Friends,

We trust you have a wonderful Christmas and a very Happy and Prosperous New Year. God has been more than wonderful towards us this whole year and we are excited about what is in store for us this coming year.

OUR CHURCH: Our main church is growing and God is giving us people saved and baptized every week. We had over 200 people saved in our services in the month of October. We had our yearly Patriotic Sunday in October and five High School bands joined us on this day and 120+ got saved!! Our attendance is consistently growing and we are praying that God would give us a large property located closer to downtown. Please pray with us for this need.

THE BIBLE COLLEGE: We held our fourth graduation of our Bible College and we had four students graduate; three men and one young lady. One of these men wants to be a missionary to Colombia, the other wants to start a new Church amongst an Indian tribe in this country and the other wants to go full time into the music ministry. What holds these folks back from doing more sooner is the lack of finances. Please pray God would provide for these men.

OUR BUSES: We are still trying to gather up the money to get the four buses we have waiting for us in Tennessee. We need these buses and we ask you to pray God would provide the money we need to get them down here soon. We have sold one of our old buses and we hope to sell another one soon to have all the money we need for shipping the buses.

THE GIRLS HOME: The government has come to us asking us to take in 40 girls from a Catholic Home which will be shutting down on December 31. Please pray we can be ready for this group of girls, that they all get saved soon after arriving in the home and that God would provide the funds for this need. This will give us about 70 in the home and we are excited to see the Lord's name glorified in all this.

RADIO PROGRAM: People have been calling in asking questions on my radio program and I even had a man walk in from off the street after hearing the program and he got saved there in the broadcasting studio. Pray that many people will listen to the program, be saved and that God would provide the \$400.00 each month to stay on the air.

MY HEALTH: My left thyroid gland was not taken out three years ago when I had surgery to extract the cancerous tumor which was on my right thyroid gland. All was well until some nodules showed up on this left gland and since there are so many and the first biopsy was inconclusive, it has been decided that I should have surgery to take it out as well. This surgery will be in January. Please pray that I do not have to have the surgery and, if necessary, that God would provide.

OUR FAMILY: Our oldest son, Anthony, will be 18 years old in January and Rachel will be 15 in February. We have many decisions to make in the future with our children, so please pray for us in this crucial time.
