

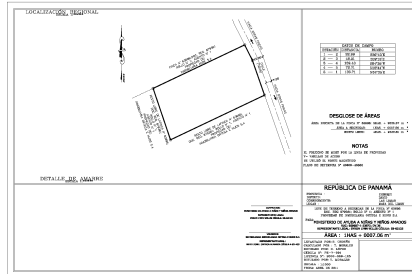

Dear Friends,



WE HAVE LAND AND A VAN! God has been so good to us. We praise the Lord for all of you who have given towards the van. This van is now in Florida and should be on its way to Panama by the time you receive this letter. It is a 2007, Ford, 15 passenger van which will be used for our orphanage. We are also very excited to have 2.5 acres of land which should be in our name by the time you receive this letter. Bro. Chris and Joan, from Nebraska, came to Panama on vacation and met us, saw the Home and decided he wanted to help by buying us this property. Our commitment to him was that we would be building our own Orphanage on this land as soon as it was bought for us. We have around \$5,000.00 on hand at this moment and trust much more will be coming in. We are praying for 100 churches or individuals that will donate \$1,000.00 each towards the construction of the Home! Thanks to all those who have already sent donations. Please join us in this worthy project. We have 26 living in the Home.

Our Church is doing well. We are now having two separate Sunday Schools and Morning Services on Sunday mornings. This has opened the door for more growth and we are averaging as of lately close to 800 on Sunday Mornings! We now have over 40 Sunday School classes every week. During the month of April we had 125 professions of faith and 50 baptisms! God has been so good to us. My wife held a Ladies Conference in May and had over 400 ladies and I had a Men's Conference in June with over 150 men participating.

Our Missionary Family going to Columbia is doing well. Bro. Morales has been traveling through Central America raising support and praise the Lord he is over 50% of what he would like to have coming in by the time they leave for Columbia in December. Please prayerfully consider supporting this family going to Columbia, sent out from our church. We thank to those churches in the States that are already sending support to the Morales Family through us. God bless you.

Our Bible College is doing well. We are having a wonderful year. One of the biggest blessings to me is that our oldest son, Anthony, is in our Bible College and is working full time in our church doing maintenance. What a blessing to see our children serving the Lord and wanting to be a part of our ministries.

We thank our Home Church for the pickup they bought us which will be coming with the van. We are excited to have newer and better vehicles for our ministries and this will make things much better and easier. The Feeding Centers are doing well and we thank all of those churches who sponsor these Centers. We are feeding on average around 50 children in each center. We will be having a few groups come to see the Centers and the Orphanage within the next couple of months.

Please pray also for my radio program for we are starting to see fruit of our labor. We also have a Missions Conference and an Old Paths Conference planned in the month of July.
